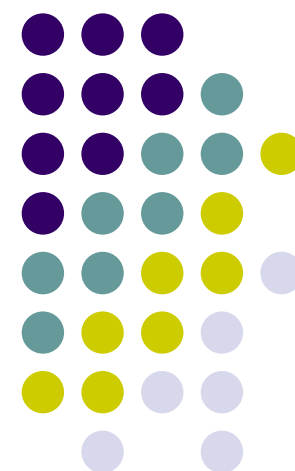

Some Conflicts and Struggles Identified by Muslim Women

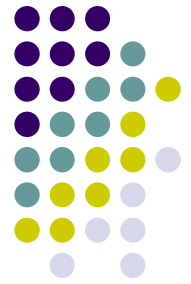


- Why are the societal sanctions against women more severe than man.
